We are committed to protecting the health and safety of all its team including singers, musicians, technicians, production staff and volunteers. Our health and safety policy is to:

- Maintain safe and healthy working conditions.
- Provide and maintain safe systems of work for all those working for or on behalf of the company and to provide members of the team with such information and supervision as they need in order to maintain these safe systems.
- Assess the Health and Safety risks of our performances and put appropriate measures in place to mitigate significant risks.
- Provide and maintain safe equipment.
- Take measures to prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health.
- Consult with self-employed persons, contractors and members of production teams on matters affecting their health and safety.
- Consult with venue managers and event companies on matters affecting Opera Anywhere team members' health and safety.
- Include health and safety as a standing item on the agenda of Opera Anywhere board meetings.

This Policy will be reviewed annually or if there are significant changes to our work practices.
